ACCOUNTING PREPARATORY COURSE 2020

Who should register for the course?

The main purpose of this <u>voluntary</u> course is to afford the opportunity to students who must register for <u>ACCC 111 and 121 and ACCF 111 and 121</u> and who did not have Accounting at school, or who want to improve their readiness for university Accounting, to better prepare themselves for university Accounting. It is not necessary for ACCS students to attend the course. The course is presented to students free of charge.

The exam that is written at the end of the course also serves as a possible indication for students of the extent to which they are prepared for the Accounting module they are enrolled for (ACCC or ACCF). The following guidelines merely serve as a **recommendation**:

Result of course	Recommended module
75% or more	ACCC 111
50% or more	ACCF 111
Under 50%	ACCS 111

If you do not achieve the above results, you are welcome to discuss the possibility of converting to a qualification with lower entrance requirements with a programme leader in the School of Accounting Sciences. However, please note that it is not compulsory to convert to another qualification as the above percentages serve as a recommendation only.

Take note!

Please note that performance in the preparatory course <u>CANNOT</u> replace the official admission requirements. This is also stated as such in the Faculty yearbook. Your chance of successfully completing your degree depends on many more factors than performance in this course. Therefore, regardless of your results for the preparatory course, you are not allowed to convert to a qualification with stricter admission requirements than the one you are currently enrolled for.

Regardless of whether you do the Accounting Preparatory Course or not and what the outcome might be, please register for the module that forms part of the curriculum that you have been accepted for. For example, you should register for ACCF 111 (if accepted based on official admission requirements) and can later change to ACCS 111 based on the outcome of the preparatory course. Consequently, students enrolling for the Accounting Preparatory Course, in the meantime, attend the accounting class (ACCC or ACCF) of the qualification they qualify for **according to their matric results**. We have an arrangement with Academic Administration that students can change their course after the preparatory course exam in early March. However, any changes are voluntary as the preparatory course cannot override official admission requirements.
