1.1 Please follow the following procedure:

Please upload the following documents with your application:

- Academic record with results or proof of registration
- Gr 12 final marks
- Motivation- why do you want to study Law@NWU
- CV

1.2 Admission requirements:

- Adhere to the minimum admission requirements; <http://studies.nwu.ac.za/undergraduate-studies/fields-study>
- Passed at least 72 credits at the other institution in one year.

You will only be admitted on condition that you pass all modules you are registered for this year in the Nov. /Dec examination.

The evaluation of your application will be finalised and credits be indicated only after we have received your year end results.

1.3 Application from 1 July until September 2019

- The application form will be send to your email address;
- The link for the submissions of documentation from 1 July until 30 September 2019 will be communicated on 1 July 2019.
- You will only be admitted on condition that you pass all modules you are registered for this year in the Nov. /Dec examination.
- **Apply by the end of September 2019**

The evaluation of your application will be finalised and credits be indicated only after we have received your year end results.

2.2 Admission requirements:

- Meet the minimum admission requirements <http://studies.nwu.ac.za/undergraduate-studies/fields-study> or
- Passed the modules registered for in your current curriculum in 2019 with an average of 60% if you do not meet the minimum admission requirements.
- Please confirm your request to change to BA/BCom in Law/LLB by sending an email to LAW@nwu.ac.za before 13 December 2019.

3 Continuation of studies (LLB 2020)

- This is applicable to all final year BA or BCom in Law students who are planning to continue with their LLB in 2020.

- Students who are completing their BA in Law in 2019 apply for qualification code 607 107 3 and curriculum code R412P.
- Students who are completing their BCom in Law in 2019 apply for qualification code 607 107 3 and curriculum code R413P.
- If a student does not complete the BA in Law degree or BCom in Law degree they will need to register for two qualifications; (the student request form for two qualifications is available on efundi under resources)
- Students may register for the LLB together with the BA or BCom in Law if they require 3 or less modules to qualify for a BA in Law or BCom in Law;
- Please note that students need to register at the relevant campus for the BA in Law or BCom in Law and then register for the LLB on PC or MC

- **Apply by the end of October 2019.**
- Accepted students will receive confirmation by the undergraduate office towards the end of November / beginning of December 2019 after the examination results have been finalised and your degree has been officially loaded.
