2. Programme and important dates for registration 2020

The Faculty of Law encourages its students to register online if possible, since it will save a great deal of time. Online registration opens on 8 January and must be completed by the 31st January 2020. If you need to consult a Faculty advisor, you are welcome to do so, but you are requested to keep in mind the schedule below.

Arrangements for specific groups

Students should attend the activities indicated in the table below for specific groups of students (no other information sessions are organized by the Faculty).

NWU students from other **non-law curricula** who have received permission to change to BA Law or B Com Law need to attend the sessions for 1st year students on 20 and 21 January 2020 at Building 25-G03 and for registration at Building 6. Furthermore, they must report to Mr Mqakama Radebe, at office G16, Building 11B who will, *inter alia*, assist them with registration.

Students **from other universities** who register in 2020 for the first time at the NWU for BA Law or B Com Law, must attend the sessions on 20th and 21st January. Furthermore, they must report to Mr Kagiso Masilo and Mr Mqakama Radebe, at offices G15 and G16, Building 11B on the 30th January who will, *inter alia*, attend to registration and the recognition of modules passed.

Students whose studies have been blocked (due to various reasons, such as termination of studies) will not be able to register online. They need to report to Mr Kagiso Masilo office G15, Building 11B as indicated in the table below.
