

Four-Page Concept Proposal

An applicant is required to furnish a **four-page concept proposal** with their application. **Your application will not be considered without this document** and will cause unnecessary delays. To prepare this document, you will have to follow the following steps:

1. Write your concept proposal **for research** by following the guidelines below:
 - 1.1 Formulate a **preliminary title** for your proposed research. The title should cover the research focus meaningfully and refer to the main aspects of the study.
 - 1.2 Identify the research problem(s) and briefly describe them. Thus, in this section, you will describe **what** you want to research.
 - 1.3 Motivate **why** it is important to conduct the research. Explain why the research will be of relevance and how it will contribute to the expansion of existing knowledge in the field of Law.
 - 1.4 Explain **how** you will conduct the research, i.e. which methods you anticipate using to conduct the research.
 - 1.5 It is your sole responsibility to write this document without the expectation of faculty guidance in this regard.

This concept proposal should be typed and **not exceed 4 pages**.
