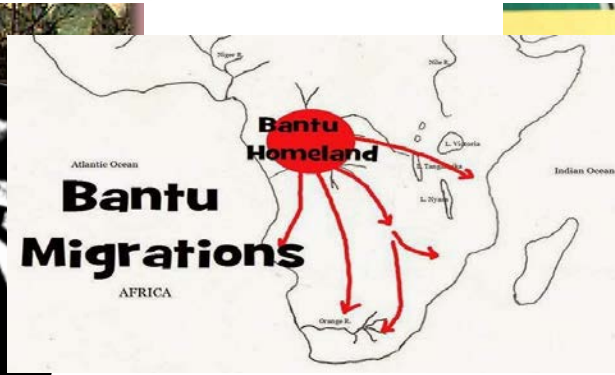
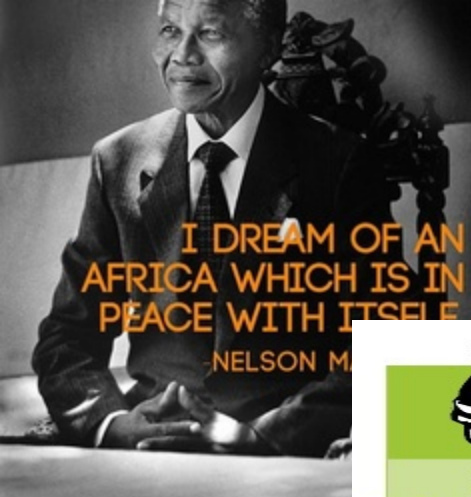

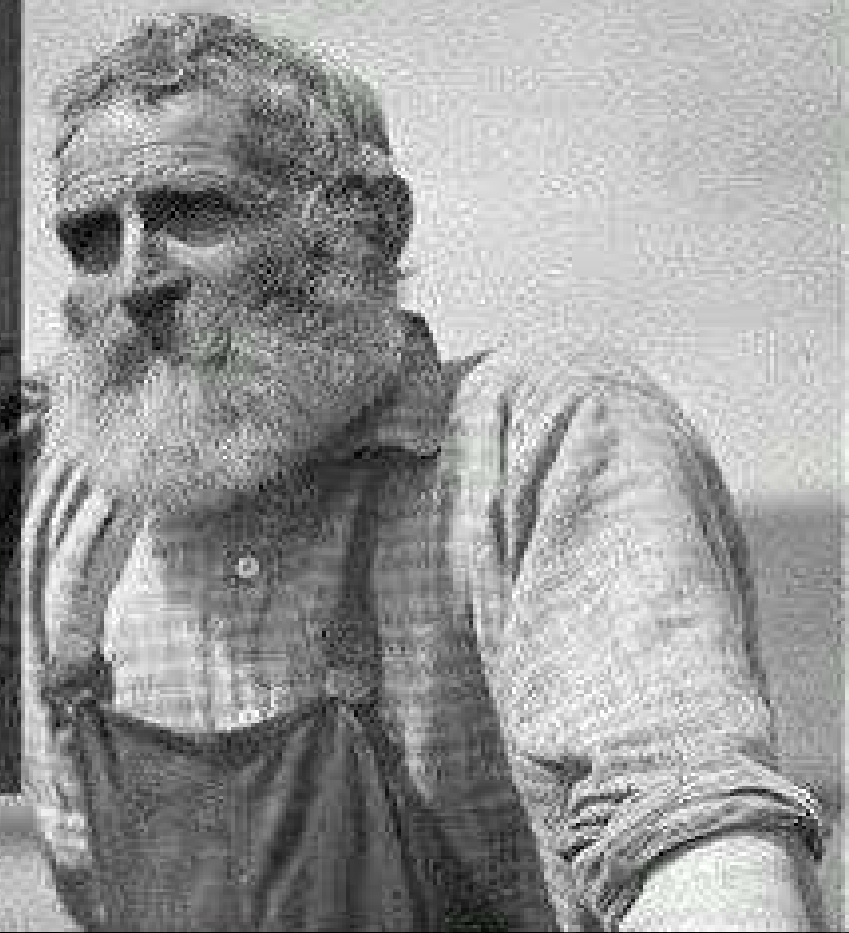

The turning point

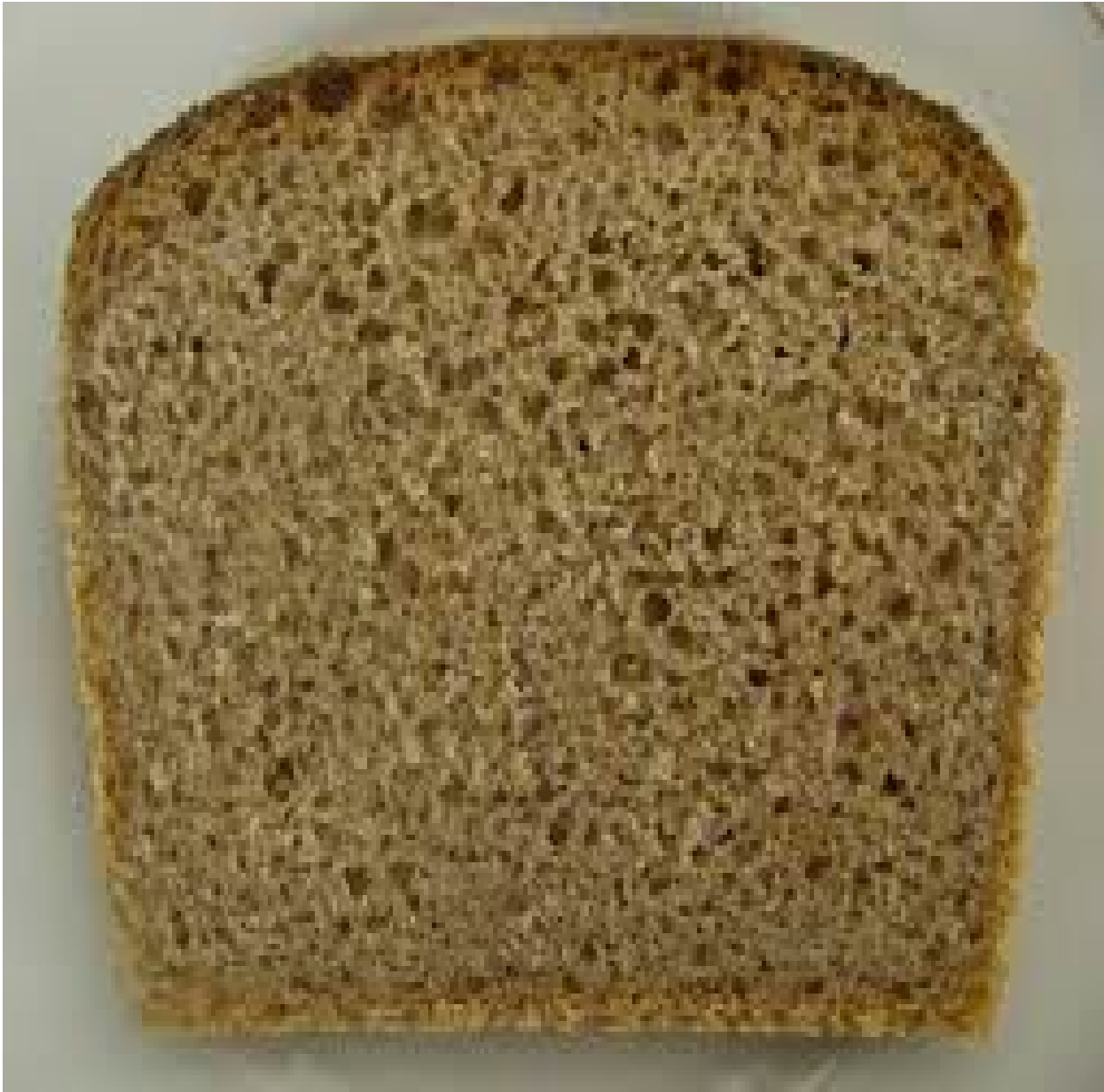


Way forward.
