Accepted contributions will appear in the open access and accredited Potchefstroom Electronic Law Journal as part of the dedicated "SARCHI CLES Series".

The SARCHI CLES Chair forms part of the Research Unit on Law, Justice and Sustainability of the Faculty of Law, North-West University, South Africa. It is funded by the National Research Foundation of South Africa. CLES is devoted to legal scholarship for sustainable urban development in South Africa, the broader African region and beyond.

The PELJ is an open access, peer-reviewed, and internationally accredited law journal, currently listed and indexed, amongst others, by IBSS, DOAJ, SSRN, AJOL, Boloka, SciELO, HeinOnline, Jstor, Web of Knowledge, SABINET, SAFLii, SciELO SA, Science Open and Google Scholar. The Editor-in-Chief is Prof Christa Rautenbach.

The Series editors invite the submission of articles, case notes, notes, book reviews and policy papers. Contributions need not be focused on South Africa or the African region. The word limits are as follows:

Articles:	7,000 to 10,000 words
Case notes:	5,000 to 10,000 words
Notes:	7,000 to 10,000 words
Policy papers:	3,000 to 5,000 words (not peer reviewed)

Accepted papers will be published online on a rolling basis.
