

PAYMENT FOR ECOSYSTEM SERVICES**A H Benjamin*****SUMMARY**

This address focuses on the legislative design for payment of ecosystem services (PES) since most countries do not have specific legislation that addresses the subject. Brazil is in the process of drafting national legislation on ecosystem services and there are several important issues that can be learnt from this experience.
